International Activity Emblem

The **International Activity Badge** is a 3-inch diameter patch which is worn as a temporary emblem on the right pocket of the Scout or Scouter to recognize participation in unit, council, and world scouting international activities. There is no time restriction for earning the patch. (3" Patch #00144 or 5" Jacket Patch #00145)
